

## **Decisions**

14/0905 River Lane Youth Football Club. The redevelopment of the facilities, which include replacing the turf with an artificial surface, installing new floodlights and providing a new car park has been approved. The construction of the earth bund, the new changing block and the footbridge were removed from the application in response to objections raised by the environment agency and by neighbours. I did not send in a LOR as I felt I could not contribute anything extra to the LORs submitted and had not been approached to write by the residents.

14/1461 43 Bridge Street (a listed building) has approval to be converted from offices to 3 dwellings.

15/0048 Spinney Cottage, Headley Rd. Approval has been given for the single storey extension to the side. (I did write raising concern about building up to the boundary after being contacted by a neighbour)

14/1895 273–9 Kingston Rd (the garage) has been refused permission to retain the very large fascia signs and totem sign.

15/0146 The Swan Centre wish to remove a sycamore tree to the rear of the building, which was given immediate approval. The tree appears to be near very close to the building, near the pub, but there was no opportunity to write about this.

## **Applications**

15/0062 14-22 Church Street. A letter of representation has been submitted to MVDC sent after it had been approved by all the committee about this large application for an extension at the rear to create a single large retail unit.
