Martyn Williams Report for LRA meeting on Monday 6th November 2017

Forward Planning Group

- 1)-The Local Plan-no new information to hand since last meeting. Thought that decision on housing requirement to be made by end November.
- 2)-Transform Leatherhead-the CRG and public meetings have now taken place. A note of the CRG meeting has been circulated. In summary-

Church Street-works are scheduled to complete mid November

Swan Centre-work will start in February on new lifts, new toilets, four new retail units and improvements to the car park. Design work on longer term improvements has started.

Riverside-Work on drawing up a planning application for Claire/James house has commenced

Bull Hill-work on this must await the findings of a traffic survey-now being organised.

High Street-a more radical programme of enhancement is to be worked up over coming weeks, following the concern expressed as to the general condition of the Street.

Flood alleviation-a temporary remedy is available if needed this winter. Intend to design a permanent solution during 2018 and implement in 2019

- 3)-Sustainable Transport Plan-the Randalls Road scheme is to be redesigned to meet more closely the funding criteria and then re-submitted during the next round of funding
- 4)-Parking Consultation-MVDCs strategy under review and central Leatherhead will be part of that.
- 5)-Kingston House Gardens-as per last meeting the FPG has heard no more since the end of last year when the owners were reconsidering their proposals.
