

Regarding Highways. There have been only a few things to report.

Action by SCC has only been a requirement to choose lights for the Conservation Areas. We have responded to Rod Shaw to say that we would prefer to see the choice made at the same time as the rest of the High Street furniture has been selected. Tin Hall was also asked to intervene and agreed to do so.

Other actions agreed by SCC:- Replacement of Leret Way pedestrian refuge promised by end of October - no action. Permanent signs to Leatherhead Hospital - no action. Other things asked for - plates saying No Cycling at each end of Church Path. Plates saying who has right of way in North Street - no action. Sign outside Lidl is still facing the wrong way - tells people No Entry to Station Road; and of course it still obstructs the footway by the bus shelter.

Mole Valley have replaced No Cycling signs in Red House Gardens with correct sign - at least at the top.

Finger Post outside the Institute was knocked down - the cast iron base was snapped off. Reported to Rod Shaw - after two weeks the post was removed from the flower bed where it had been laid to rest. Hopefully it will be revived.
