Item 6b-Forward Planning Group report

Transform Leatherhead-the Community Reference Group meeting postponed from September duly took place on Thursday October 13th.The following matters were discussed-

The current work in Church Street is to create a temporary service bay for Waitrose.Work on the permanent bay will start in January/February and take approx. 3 months.

The Transform team have started a consultation exercise on 3 aspects of the project-

- a sustainable transport plan that involves the construction of 2 new cycle routes.One on the north side of Randalls Road from the Station to Cleeve Road ,which will not involve any narrowing of the road.The other on the west side of Waterway Road from the Park to the Pumping Station,which will involve road narrowing and possibly a one way light controlled route over the bridge for large vehicles.

- a flood alleviation proposal that involves a new additional river channel across Common Meadow.

- what changes residents think should be made to the car parking provision of central Leatherhead in general and of the Swan Centre in particular.

The consultation will be widely advertised in the local press/on MVDCs web-site and will include exhibitions on November 12th, 19th and 26th.

Kingston House Gardens-the Neighbourhood Action Group are pushing for more information but query whether anything more will be forthcoming until Circle lodge a planning application.
