Riverside

The Leatherhead Residents' Association responded to concerns brought by some of its members about the Riverside Walk development plans on lands owned by Mole Valley District Council. As a result of a petition signed by residents, alterations were made to the new river side path: a large lay-by (25ft x 16ft) was removed from the area by the Thorncroft Bridge to preserve the countrified atmosphere; and the kissing gate was altered to allow access to all disabled persons.

Church Street

Plans to redevelop Church Street were drawn up which included a large civic space in front of the Theatre resulting in a loss of 5/6 on-street parking spaces, and presenting serious problems of cost and disruption to trade for a minimum of 7 months. 85% of the responses to our questionnaire expressed their concerns about this plan. Together with the Chamber of Commerce and Leatherhead*Ahead*, the LRA objected to the proposal, and the proposed design was eventually abandoned.

Car park behind Ranmore House, Elm Road

Parking by the general public has always been allowed in this car park in the evenings and at weekends. The LRA noticed that the new owners of Ranmore House were preventing this, and therefore contacted the MVDC Planning Department. Parking in the evenings and weekends was then restored.
