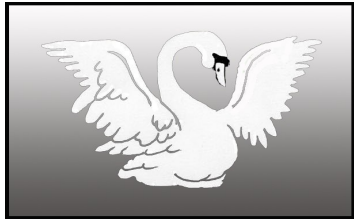

Dear Member and/or Road Steward,

As explained at our last few meetings, because the July Newsletter was a bit late, it was decided to wait until the ideas for Leatherhead from Transform were on the table and open to the public before starting on the next one, in February.. This has meant, of course, that these normal Renewal Reminders are having to be delivered separately. You will note the slight increase in our subscription and we apologize for it, but the cost of room hire and stationery etc. does not go down

We hope you will continue to be part of the Association which works very hard to make Leatherhead a pleasant place to live. In the past year we have

- Attended numerous meetings in connection with the Transform Leatherhead project and submitted ideas and thoughts to the team working on this.
- Helped to beautify the Town centre by keeping plants flourishing – See Nat. West bank, the big planters opposite the P.O. and the small ones in front of what used to be Alan's antiques
- Taken an active interest in planning applications (e.g. new retail shop near the Cycleshop), but also plenty of others.
- Been vociferous in trying to protect our Green Belt, e.g. trying to save the Barnett Wood Lane allotments.
- Organised pleasant days when others can view some of the best gardens in the town.
- Supported the campaigners for the re-surfacing of Forty Foot Road.
- Supported the Leach Grove Wood neighbourhood in their desire to get that area designated as a "Village Green" and so, although still owned by the NHS, it has legal protection to remain as it is, a recreation and play area.
- Fought for the survival of both the Epsom and Leatherhead hospitals.
- Helped the Leatherhead Community Gardens to develop and flourish.
- Removed litter and other foul mess from streets, pavements and footpaths and encouraged youngsters to be more care with what they throw away via a large exhibition of their work.
- We are currently trying to keep abreast of any Crossrail ideas and also endeavouring to ensure that developers respect our trees and GB as much as we do.
- Joined in with others to improve our flood defences by removing Himalayan Balsam along the river bank.

If you would like to join our team efforts on any of the above, do contact us via the website or drop a letter into our box in the Institute. We have 10 Open Meetings per year, 2 with a Speaker and 2 Open Committee meetings. Each side of the AGM there is a closed committee meeting.
