

Martyn Williams Report for LRA meeting on Monday 4th September 2017

Forward Planning Group

1)-The Local Plan-following the last LRA meeting, the comments made on the draft report were reflected in a revised draft. This has now been finalised and submitted to MVDC.

2)-Transform Leatherhead-the next public meeting will take place at 19.00 on Wednesday 1st November in the Theatre. Prior to this there will be a CRG meeting on Thursday 26th October at 19.00 in The Police Federation Building.

Church Street-works are well advanced and on schedule to complete at the end of October. It should be noted that from Thursday 7th September for a max. of 6 weeks there will be no vehicular access from Church Street to High Street. If necessary, for goods vehicles only, access to High Street may be possible from North Street.

Swan Centre-work on formulating proposed improvements is on-going now that the budgets have been approved. New lifts are due to be installed in Q1 2018.

Riverside- MVDCs proposal to spend £200k drawing up development plans for Claire / James House will now be submitted to the Executive for approval on 26th September.

Bull Hill-as per last meeting, MVDC are still considering what commercial space is viable in this location. Discussions with possible traffic consultants are ongoing.

3)-Sustainable Transport Plan-as per last meeting an application to the LEP as regards finance for the Randalls Road option will be made by 8th September.

4)-Parking Consultation-as per the last meeting there has been no further progress following the results of the survey being published. MVDC are about to trial a new “hi-tech” pay-and-display parking ticket machine. This is likely to be located in the Church Street car park adjacent to Waitrose

5)-Kingston House Gardens-as per last meeting, the FPG has heard no more since the end of last year when the owners were reconsidering their proposals.
