

## **27/02/12 Green Mole Forum (GMF) Meeting 7pm at Pippbrook**

The future of GMF was discussed, and it was decided that GMF continue in a changed format, due to overlap with Action Surrey.

It was agreed that the Website be redesigned as a 1 or 2 page site listing 'green' groups in Mole Valley area and Surrey-wide groups such as Action Surrey.

Regular meetings at Pippbrook will be discontinued.

Groups in Ashted/Bookham/Fetcham/Leatherhead plan to arrange informal occasional meetings as they are geographically close, to share ideas and activities and will be meeting April 4th.

Flip Cargill met with Becky Weller 20 - 3 - 12 (Waste Minimisation Adviser to SCC) to look into SCC setting up a Surrey Green Network, and helping groups in practical ways. This meeting will be discussed further on April 4th when Transition Bookham, Ashted and LRA environment sub group get together.

Contact with Transition Dorking will continue via newsletter exchange.

It's interesting to note that Transition Dorking have discontinued open meetings as their projects – food float, community orchard, pop-up restaurant, and reviving the walled garden in Pixham are more effective in raising community awareness, support and activity.

An occasional large public event will be organised between all Mole Valley groups. A Zero Carbon presentation by the Centre For Alternative Technology is being discussed for 2013.

Funds will be retained to pay for the website and for large public meetings. Also for funding assistance for local group projects.
